

Limited Shipments of Two Varieties of Milo's Kitchen® Dog Treats Voluntarily Recalled Due to Potentially Elevated Levels of Thyroid Hormone

We are voluntarily recalling specific shipments of two varieties of our dog treats because the products have the potential to contain elevated levels of a beef thyroid hormone.

However, with prolonged consumption these symptoms may increase in severity and may include vomiting, diarrhea, and rapid or labored breathing.
